

The Vocational Graduate Certificate in Christian Ministry and Theology is not only designed for people who want to build on previous theological and church leadership studies, it is also for those holding an undergraduate degree (or equivalent) in a discipline other than theology, who wish to upgrade their knowledge and skills in these fields.

The Vocational Graduate Certificate and Vocational Graduate Diploma are the equivalent of the post-graduate qualifications offered by some higher education providers.

Certificate IV in Training & Assessment

Certificate IV in Community Development CHC40808

This course equips Christian Community Workers to facilitate community members working together to influence and guide the future of their church and/or community.

Global Discipleship Training (GDT)

Can you imagine the thrill of living and learning in another culture - normally overseas? Here is the opportunity to combine study for a *Certificate IV in Community Services Work (CHC40708)* with experience, and do it in a cross-cultural setting (with an optional *Certificate III in Christian Ministry and Theology (30771QLD)*).

CALAM Training and Global InterAction (GIA) jointly offer the Global Discipleship Training course. This certificate is only 5 months in length but could change your life forever. As a student you will attend Bible College for 12 weeks at CALAM Training (Townsville), living on campus in community. Here you will develop knowledge, skills and attitudes in Christian discipleship, Biblical understanding and cross-cultural communication.

Following the successful completion of 12 weeks in Bible College, you will be assigned to a cross-cultural placement where you will continue your studies by distance education for 8 weeks. You will then spend another 2 weeks debriefing, finalising assessment work and graduating in Townsville.

Certificate III & IV in Christian Ministry and Theology

30771QLD & 30772QLD

These *Certificates in Christian Ministry and Theology* are part of a three-tier "nested" program that can continue through to the *Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology*. It will take twelve months of full-time study to complete the Certificate IV (which incorporates the first six months of study required for the Certificate III in Christian Ministry and Theology).

This one-year course (Certificate IV) will equip lay people for ministry and leadership in the local church/workplace, as well as enhance personal growth. The training sessions, structure, and course timetable are designed to accommodate a wide range of student needs.

Distance, part-time and full-time students will find the course not only challenging but also convenient.

Certificate IV in Community Services Work

CHC40708

Certificate IV in Community Services Work prepares students to be competent in Community Work in a variety of settings ranging from local church ministry through to all kinds of secular options. This course is offered in two modes:

- 12 months (or part-time) in a local church placement
- 6 months through the fast-track cross-cultural Global Discipleship Training Course

Certificate IV in Teaching Conversational English (TESOL)

30664QLD

This course has been designed for those who wish to develop a Christian ministry through teaching English. This is a comprehensive TESOL qualification.

This nationally recognised training aims to provide TESOL skills to volunteers, industry trainers and community aid workers dealing with speakers of other languages in Australia and overseas. The focus of the course is on training to teach conversation and listening skills to learners of the English language. Teaching writing, reading, grammar and vocabulary are also thoroughly addressed.

Limited to certain locations

Townsville: Three compulsory 1-week intensives and a practical component of 25 hours teaching time over a 6 month period. The next course will commence March 2011.

Higher level qualifications in Christian Ministry and Theology

The following courses are designed to equip you for mission placement, church planting, ministry in the local church, and growth as a disciple of Jesus Christ.

Each higher qualification builds on the foundation of the matching lower-level qualification. Students can expect to graduate from these courses with a deeper knowledge of the Bible and valuable practical skills for ministry both formally and informally. The projects covered include specialisations allowing you to focus on your main area of ministry. Throughout this study, students will engage in hands-on practical ministry within a Biblical framework.

Students may study **full-time** or **part-time**, on-campus or externally.
