Reasons for Your Faith (Apologetics)

This course is concerned with the systematic defence of Christianity. It explores the most frequently raised questions about the Christian faith including creation-evolution and the limits of science, the reliability of the Biblical text, the problem of suffering, the case for the resurrection, and many more. It will provide a foundation for sharing one's faith as there is a new confidence in having a strong grasp of the issues people may raise.

Interpreting the Bible (Hermeneutics)

This course presents general principles for understanding the Bible including a thorough overview of the different types of literature that it includes. It is designed to enhance personal Bible study and will be very helpful for those in leadership to explain it more effectively—especially those leading study groups. It lays a proper foundation for understanding the difficult passages and is an opportunity to learn new insights.
